Conducted March 5-8, 2021






Poll details

- Designed to gauge importance of postsecondary education in Ontario, awareness of current fiscal situation at Laurentian, and support for additional funding for universities facing financial difficulties.
- EKOS conducted Ontario-wide online poll of 1,063 Ontario residents, 18 years of age or older.
- The associated margin of error is plus or minus 3.0% at a 0.05 confidence interval (i.e. 19 times out of 20).






Please rate the extent to which you agree or disagree with the following statement: **A university education is valuable for today's young people**







Thinking not just of today but over the next five years, what priority should the provincial government place on postsecondary education?



Thinking not just of today but over the next five years, what priority should the federal government place on postsecondary education?




How important do you consider Laurentian University to be for the people of Northern Ontario?



Northern sample




